





uControl Extension Not Safe to Load

The kernel extension was not loaded because it has been marked unsafe. This is a precaution to prevent repeated crashes. However, this may also happen if "Configure at Login" is not checked. Please check for an update if it was marked unsafe due to a crash.

Note: there is a bug whereby desktop machines seem to be marked unsafe for no good reason.



 Expert Options

 Load at Startup

Loads the kernel extension when the machine boots. If the machine should fail to boot when loading—possible when the OS is upgraded—it will not load on the next boot.

Extension is not loaded.


 Load Extension

 Configure at Login

Configures the kernel extension when you login. (Specifically launches the uControlHelper when you login.)

 Debug Logging

Prints debug information to the log file:

`/var/log/system.log`
